Note: Watertown's Italian-American Civic Association established the William I. Graf Award in 1954 to honor the top graduating male athletes at Watertown High School and Immaculate Heart Academy/Immaculate Heart Central. In 1977, the award was first presented to the top male and female graduating athletes at both WHS and IHA/IHC. The Graf Award was discontinued at IHA/IHC in 1979 when, in its place, the Italian-American Civic Association established the Clarence "Boots" Gaffney Award and began presenting it to the top graduating male and female athletes.
